- **1. Meetings:** We held our monthly Department Head meeting on September 3rd and later that day attended the Oxford County Chamber "Business After Hours" at Cyndi's Dockside with Selectmen Robinson and Walker. Also, the CEDC meeting later featured a speaker from Sebago Technics. Tuesday the 8th the Safety Committee met with Liaison Selectman Tetenman in attendance.
- **2. Finance Director:** We have offered the Finance Director position to Sharon Chammings of Oxford and she has accepted. Sharon is currently the Finance Director in Fryeburg and will be starting here on October 5th.
