Crack-Filling Roads

Proseal LLC has completed filling cracks on this year's list of roads, but certain *patching* on Hardscrabble Road has not been completed yet. This year's crack-filled roads include the following: Hardscrabble Road beginning at the Auburn town line to the mobile home park, a portion of Lewiston Junction Road that was re-paved a couple of years ago, Hackett Mills Road from Harris Hill Road to Route 121, Pulsifer Road from Bailey Hill Road to the dead end, and parts of Schellinger Road prior to receiving the 1" top coat of pavement. The additional patching on Hardscrabble Road is proposed to cost \$4,700. A total of \$13,287 was paid for the other crack-filling work.
