- **1. Meetings:** On Friday the 22nd we held a bid opening for the demolition project; we will discuss this further in this document. Monday the 25th the three town managers met with the RSU 16 Superintendant and Operations Manager; basically we discussed what's been going on in the Towns and the School Department. On Sunday the 31st I did a short presentation to the Range Pond's Association and updated them on Town activities regarding our waterways.
- **2. Employee News:** We have retained a temporary person to fill the Finance/Assessor Assistant position. They will be starting Monday the 8th.
- 3. Cable License: I have sent a letter to Charter Cable acknowledging their request to convene cable license negotiations. I have also forwarded each Selectman a copy of the MMA "Municipal Officials Guide to Local Regulation of Cable Television" for their review. I'm recommending the board take a month or so to digest the information and we can then decide how to proceed. The current license is valid until 4/28/19.
- 4. Tripp Lake Beach Project: We are moving along quickly and have done the paving on the sidewalk and the ADA ramp along with the mulching.
- 5. **Demo Update:** I have setup the asbestos mitigation which is scheduled to start today (8/2) and will take maybe two days. Once completed I'll get a certificate to pass on to the contractor we'll be hiring later this evening when you accept the recommended bid.

- 6. Sewer Extension Meeting: The Town of Mechanic Falls has put together an initial meeting to discuss getting a sewer line to Five Corners. I had a brief sit down with the Mechanic Falls Town Manager and Sewer Department Superintendant on 7/20 to hear their thoughts on the subject. The meeting will be held at AVCOG on September 13th at 10 AM. Unfortunately I will be out of State, I'm recommending at least one Selectman attend and I will arrange to have our DPW Director and Planning/Code Enforcement Officer there.
- **7. Conservation Easement:** Conservation Commission members, Selectman Gallagher and I met on July 22nd with Betsy Cook of the New England Forestry Foundation to update and clarify where we are in the Conservation Easement process. We now have Fred Huntress working with a surveyor establishing the official boundaries of the 95 acre easement. Once this is done the Foundation will complete the final easement document and send to the Board for final approval.
- **8. Road Closure:** The Maine DOT will be closing Route 11 from the Five Corners intersection to White Oak Hill Road from August 8th to 11th to replace several culverts. Traffic will be detoured to White Oak Hill Road; local residents will only be allowed in this area.
- **9. Tax Rate:** Reminder, our Assessing agent is preparing the documentation to set the tax rate at the next BOS/Assessor's meeting of August 16th. The Assessing Agent will be in the office all day on August the 9th.

Financial Statement Issues for FY2016

We are 100% through FY2016: 87.09% of budgeted expenditures have been expended and 105.89% of budgeted revenues have been received to date.

Revenue:

To date, we have collected \$132,540.30 over the budgeted revenues (please note that this amount is less than last month because of payments made out of the Ambulance Fees). We always receive certain State Reimbursements in the month of July for the prior fiscal year (these will be adjusted back into FY2016 during the Audit process.)

I have adjusted the Tax Commitment and Use of Reserves Revenue to reflect accurate budget balances.

Expenses:

Budgeted expenses are updated as much as is possible. Normally, invoices for the current month do not get received until the beginning of the next month; so we will be posting expenses incurred in FY2016 in the archive year through the end of July.

BOS Reports will be generated for both FY2016 and FY2017 through the middle of August 2016.

A MESSAGE TO THE TAXPAYERS AND THE PARENTS OF THE STUDENTS AT RSU-16 IN POLAND.

On June 23, 2016 there was an article in the Lewiston Sun on Poland Regional High School building an addition onto Whitter Middle School in Poland. When I read that article, I was stunned. Nothing was said about the lack of Public Sewer. These schools are operating on a 17 year old septic system which could fail almost anytime, and if that happens, these two schools have a very difficult problem, with no simple solution.

Seven years ago, there was a proposal to extend the town sewer out to the school complex at a cost of Five Million (\$5,000,000) Dollars, but it was never done. Today's cost would be at least \$8,000,000, to \$10,000,000.

Add the sewer line cost to the school addition cost of \$4,000,000 and the total cost will probably reach \$12,000,000 to \$14,000,000.

If this septic system fails at any time in the future, whether it is in the next two years, or 15 years from now, the School Union will have to close down both schools, install a concrete holding tank in the ground to hold 5,000 to 10,000 gallons of effluent, and have it pumped out every night. Then the School Union has to bid out the new sewer line from downtown Mechanic Falls out to the High School complex, and bond the new sewer line at 3 % annual interest over a period of about 15 years. The taxpayers are going to be committed to paying the monthly and annual costs of this new sewer line bond, without having any opportunity to vote.

If RSU – 16 has to commit to installing a new sewer line at anytime in the future at a cost of \$10,000,000, and has to bond it at an annual interest rate of three (3 %) percent over 15 years, the monthly cost for the taxpayers of Poland, Mechanic Falls and Minot will be \$69,000 a month for the next 180 months. That is an annual cost to the taxpayers of over \$828,000 a year for the next 15 years, and the taxpayers will never have an opportunity to vote on it.

I have an alternative plan that has never been publicly discussed by anyone in the school administration, nor by any of the RSU – 16 Directors. I believe that if I could make a two hour presentation to the taxpayers and to the parents of the three communities involved, I could save the taxpayers of RSU-16 at least \$15,000,000, and quite possibly as much as \$30,000,000, over the next 40 years, and greatly relieve the overcrowding of the school system over that same period.

In case you missed my letter to the editor which was published in the Lewiston Sun on Saturday, July 16, 2016 at the very bottom of page A 6, I have enclosed a copy of that article.

If the possibility of a septic system failure and the ensuing financial and other problems associated with it concerns you, and you would like to hear an alternative, I hope you will get a message to your Superintendent and your RSU - 16 Directors that you would like them to schedule a public hearing as soon as possible, so everyone involved will be able to hear the very best solution to these problems, so all of these issues can be considered before the building committee and the Architectural team get too far along on the present planning to expand Bruce Whittier Middle School.

Since I have not been able to locate and confirm the addresses and the phone numbers of most of your directors, I will leave it up to the taxpayers and the parents to reach out to them, and to your fellow taxpayers and parents to be sure everyone is aware of what I propose to do, and see if we can't get it scheduled for a public hearing in the very near future.

A disaster waiting to happen

On June 23, there was an article in the Sun Journal about Poland building an addition onto the Whittier Middle School. When I read the article, I was stunned — nothing was said about the lack of a public sewerage system. The middle school shares a 17-year-old septic system with the high school. Even with the best of maintenance, septic systems have been known to fail.

Seven years ago, there was a proposal to extend the town sewer out to the school complex. Cost at that time was estimated at \$5 million, but the work was never done. The cost today would probably top \$8 million, maybe as much as \$10 million. Add that cost to the cost of the school addition and the total cost will be well past \$12 million.

I am worried that the septic system, burdened with even more students, will fail. If it did, the school union would have to close down both the middle school and the high school. The school union would have to bid out a new sewer line from downtown Mechanic Falls to the school complex. In the short term, it would have to come up with a way to handle the effluent, perhaps with a holding tank that would need to be pumped out frequently. Taxpayers would be committed to paying the monthly and annual costs of any stop-gap measure, plus the cost of a new sewer-line bond, all without having any opportunity to vote.

RE: Recommended CEDC Bylaw Changes

The CEDC approved the recommendations by the Board of Selectmen and would like the Board to adopt the bylaws with the following changes:

Article V: Code of Conduct

All members of the CEDC are expected to handle themselves in a professional manner. No use of the privilege of membership on the CEDC, nor any information obtained thereby, shall be used to secure personal profit, special privileges, favors or exemptions for themselves or any other person.

Members of the CEDC must declare a conflict of interest and recuse themselves from debate and voting on any matter where they have a financial interest, or the potential to benefit personally or professionally from participation in a matter.

All members are required to sign a confidentiality agreement at the beginning of each appointed term.

Article IX: Contractor Consultant Oversight

The CEDC will serve as a steering committee for any paid contractor consultant hired by the Selectpersons for the sole purpose of economic development. Contractor Consultants will report monthly to the CEDC, submitting an itemized scope of work, as well as invoices for recommendation of payment by the Board of Selectpersons.

Article X: Contracts, Checks, Deposits and Funds

The CEDC may not enter into legally binding contracts; only the Board of Selectpersons may do so.

The CEDC may authorize such expenditures as they deem appropriate and within their budget and scope—of purpose without limitation by the Board of Selectpersons. The CEDC must have all financial transactions (deposits and expenditures) conducted through the Town's staff, accounting software and bank funds.

TOWN OF POLAND

Bylaws of the Poland Community and Economic Development Committee

Article I: Authority and Name

By authority of the Poland Board of Selectpersons there shall be formed an entity named "Poland Community and Economic Development Committee (CEDC)."

Article II: Purposes

To promote the development of Poland's community and economic resources by advising and recommending to the Board of Selectpersons appropriate strategies to build a stronger economy, tax base and employment base; to assist local businesses in locating and expanding their commerce in Poland, to advise and assist in the management and utilization of TIF districts and other economic development tools, to assist the Town Manager in the management of grants and other funding as may become available for community and economic development.

Article III: Offices

The public records of the CEDC shall be maintained at the Poland Town Office, 1231 Maine Street, Poland ME 04274. Confidential records shall be so marked and shall also be kept at the aforementioned location.

Article IV: Members

There shall be eleven members and two alternate members on the CEDC, all appointed by the Board of Selectpersons for staggered three year terms. Nine of those members shall be from registered Poland voters at large and/or Poland business owners. Four shall be liaison positions, representing the Municipal Department, Budget Committee, Code Enforcement and a member of the Board of Selectpersons. There are no inherent term limits for CEDC members, except as may be determined through the Board of Selectpersons' appointment process. Alternate members will be used if a regular member is not present at a meeting and this shall be noticed at the beginning of the meeting and recognized in the minutes that the alternate member is a voting member for the meeting.

Attendance is essential; three (3) or more consecutive unexcused absences may result in a member's removal from the CEDC by the Board of Selectpersons.

If a vacancy occurs on the CEDC before a member's term is complete, the new appointee shall complete the term that is vacant.

Article V: Code of Conduct

All members of the CEDC are expected to handle themselves in a professional manner. No use of the privilege of membership on the CEDC, nor any information obtained thereby, shall be used to secure personal profit, special privileges, favors or exemptions for themselves or any other person.

Members of the CEDC must declare a conflict of interest and recuse themselves from debate and

voting on any matter where they have a financial interest, or the potential to benefit personally or professionally from participation in a matter.

Article VI: Officers

Each July, the CEDC shall elect officers from among their members to serve for one fiscal year. Any member of the CEDC, including the liaison positions, may hold any office. The officers of the Board shall be Chairperson, Vice Chairperson, Secretary, and Treasurer. There are no inherent term limits for these officer positions.

Chairperson: It shall be the duty of the Chairperson of the CEDC to establish the agenda and to conduct orderly meetings, to ensure minutes are kept and properly distributed and stored, and to ensure that the CEDC budgets and funding are properly accounted. Any member may request an item be placed on the agenda by notifying the Chair in writing at least 72 hours of the next stated meeting.

Vice Chairperson: It shall be the duty of the Vice Chairperson of the CEDC to fulfill the duties of the Chairperson in their absence. The vice Chairperson will also chair sub-committees of the CEDC as delegated by the Chairperson.

Treasurer: It shall be the duty of the Treasurer of the CEDC to ensure that the CEDC budgets and funding are properly accounted and reported to the CEDC.

Secretary: It shall be the duty of the Secretary of the CEDC to ensure that attendance is taken and that minutes of the proceedings are kept and properly distributed and stored, and to demarcate said minutes and notes into those that are "public records" and those that are "confidential."

Paid consultants or Town staff may be called upon to assist in the fulfillment of any of the above duties.

Any officer may be removed by a two-thirds (2/3) vote of a quorum of the CEDC. The secretary shall give notice of removal to the officer not more than ten (10) days subsequent to the action. A vacancy in the officers of the CEDC may be filled by a majority of the members of the CEDC.

Article VII: Meetings

Meetings shall be held monthly at a time and place to be determined annually each July 1. Meetings shall be open to the general public, except where a discussion item is of a confidential nature, in which case the CEDC shall reference the section of Maine State Law that provides for discussions in executive session.

Quorum: 50% of the number of filled positions (4 needed at 7) constitutes a quorum. A quorum is required for conducting any business of the CEDC.

When voting, if a procedural question should occur, the CEDC will use Robert's Rules of Order.

Article VII Section 2: Special Meetings

Special meetings may be called at any time by order of the Chairperson or by written request of three (3) regular members. Notice of any formal special meeting shall be given to all Committee members at least forty-eight (48) hours prior to the scheduled starting time of the meeting by a personal conversation with each Committee member, and/or voice mail, and/or e-mail.

Notice of special meetings will be as dictated by the Town for open meetings.

Article VII Section 3: Informal Meetings

Informal meetings (such as Annual Report preparation meetings, preparation for issue discussion, adhoc sub-committees, etc.) may be called by any member. These meetings have no requirement for committee member attendance, written record or documentation or prior announcement to the public. Any recommendations formulated at these meetings shall be brought to a regular meeting. No votes shall be taken.

Article VIII: Ad-Hoc Groups

Ad-hoc groups may be created by the Committee, as it may deem necessary, to expedite its work. The Chairperson will appoint members of ad-hoc groups. Ad-hoc groups shall make reports at regularly scheduled meetings.

Article IX: Consultant Oversight

The CEDC will serve as a steering committee for any paid consultant hired by the Selectpersons for the sole purpose of economic development. Consultants will report monthly to the CEDC, submitting an itemized scope of work, as well as invoices for recommendation of payment by the Board of Selectpersons.

Article X: Contracts, Checks, Deposits and Funds

The CEDC may not enter into legally binding contracts; only the Board of Selectpersons may do so.

The CEDC may authorize such expenditures as they deem appropriate and within their budget and scope. The CEDC must have all financial transactions (deposits and expenditures) conducted through the Town's staff, accounting software and bank funds.

Article XI: Books and Records

The fiscal year of the CEDC shall be July 1st through June 30th annually. The CEDC shall ensure that an annual reporting of attendance, activities and fund utilization is filed with the Board of Selectpersons upon conclusion of the fiscal year.

Article XII: Amendment to Bylaws of <u>Community and Economic Development Committee</u> (CEDC)

These by-laws may be altered, amended or repealed by the Board of Selectpersons with at least thirty (30) days written notice to the full membership of the CEDC at such meeting of an intention to alter, amend, or repeal these by-laws.

Nomination Process – Each year member municipalities have an opportunity to vote on the election of the proposed MMA Vice President and municipal officials to serve on the MMA Executive Committee. A five-member Nominating Committee was appointed in March to review nominations submitted by municipal officials and conduct interviews with those municipal officials qualifying and interested in serving as the MMA Vice President and Executive Committee. The MMA Nominating Committee completed its task in May and put forth a Proposed Slate of Nominees for 2017 to member municipalities.

<u>Petition Process</u> – As part of the May mailing, information was also provided on the MMA Petition Process. Pursuant to the MMA Bylaws, nominations may also be made by Petition signed by a majority of the municipal officers in each of at least 5 member municipalities. The deadline for receipt of nominations by petition was Friday, July 1, by 4:30 pm. There were no municipal officials nominated by petition.

It is now time for each member municipality to cast its official vote.

<u>Election Process</u> – Enclosed you will find the MMA Voting Ballot which includes the proposed Slate of Nominees to serve on the MMA Executive Committee as selected by the MMA Nominating Committee. A brief biographical sketch on each nominee listed on the MMA Voting Ballot is enclosed for your reference. You will note that unlike municipal elections, MMA does not provide for "Write-in Candidates" since our process includes an opportunity to nominate a candidate by petition, as noted above.

The MMA Voting Ballot must be signed by a majority of the municipal officers <u>or</u> a municipal official designated by a majority of the municipal officers, and received by the Maine Municipal Association by 12:00 noon on Friday, August 12. We have enclosed a self-addressed self-stamped envelope for your convenience. The MMA Voting Ballots will be counted that afternoon and the election results confirmed under the direction of MMA President Stephan Bunker.

Election results will be available by contacting the MMA Executive Office or by visiting the MMA website at www.memun.org on Friday, August 12, after 4:00 p.m. A formal announcement of the election results will be made at the MMA Annual Business Meeting being held Wednesday, October 5, at the Bangor Cross Insurance Center. Newly elected Executive Committee members will be introduced at the MMA Awards Luncheon and Annual Business Meeting and officially take office on January 1, 2017.
