CEO Neal stated that the plan presented does not meet the landscaping requirements of Section 508.30.D.1. The Board could accept the plan as presented but would need to waive the standards. Ms. Foley stated that because of sightline concerns the standards couldn't be met.

Main-Land Development Consultants, Inc is representing Matt New (Applicant) in his Application for Sketch Plan Review in the Town of Poland.

The applicant is exploring the feasibility of constructing a new car wash on Route 26 in Poland. The subject parcel is located on Tax Map 15, Lot 5C. The applicant is interested in and has been in communication with the lot owner, Kimball & Corcoran, Inc., for purchase of the lot. Purchase of the property is dependent on the feasibility of development and preliminary approval by the town. The roughly one-acre lot is part of a subdivision which was intended for commercial use and is currently cleared and undeveloped. A copy of the original subdivision plan is attached to this submittal.

The preliminary layout of the new facility will have one automatic wash bay, three self-serve wash bays, and a mechanical room. The lot is served by municipal water and will utilize a private subsurface wastewater disposal system in conjunction with a 100% water recycle system.

In addition to town review, the Applicant will be working with Maine DOT to confirm an entrance and curb cut.

Main-Land and the Applicant look forward to meeting with the Poland Planning Board for sketch plan review on August 22, 2023 or the next available opening.

Enclosed please find a Shoreland Zoning Application (Exhibit 1) and supporting documents regarding an expansion of use for an existing structure on 155 Loon Point Lane in Poland.

The property is located at 155 Loon Point Lane and being shown as Lot 7 on the Town of Poland Tax Map 47 (Exhibit 6). The property is currently owned by Gregory and Karen Henderson as described in a deed dated July 26, 2013 and recorded at the Androscoggin County Registry of Deeds in Book 8736, Page 113 (Exhibit 8). The property contains 28,642 SF. consisting of ± 109 ° of frontage on Loon Point Lane and ± 248 ° of shore frontage on Thompson Lake and is located within the Limited Residential District and a small portion in the Farm and Forest District. The total existing impervious area within said lot consists of $\pm 5,501.1$ SF which includes the existing structure w/decks, eaves, stairs, landings, walkways and existing gravel drive and being at $\pm 19.2\%$.

The current existing improvements consist of the house structure, eaves, attached decks and steps (1,497.1 SF); shed (198.7 SF); gravel driveway (3,393.7 SF); and paths and other unvegetated areas (411.5 SF) for a total of 5,501.1 SF and being shown on the Site Plan (Exhibit 10). Most of the improvements are located 100+ feet from the shoreline (4,773.2 SF). A portion (421.8 SF) of the existing structure and gravel walkway (164.7 SF) falls within 75 feet – 100 feet from the shoreline. A portion of the gravel walkway (37.60 SF) is located within 50 feet – 75 feet from the shoreline. A stone walkway (83.0 SF) and a portion of the dock (20.7 SF) are located within 50 feet of the shoreline.

The current existing roof height at the peak is 33.5' based on an average of the lowest adjacent grades. The finished improvements will maintain the same.

A portion of the property falls within a Special Flood Hazard Zone 23001C0287E with an effective date of July 8, 2013 (Exhibit 8); however, none of the existing buildings and / or current improvements fall within the flood zone. All proposed improvements will not be impacted by said flood zone and there are no known wetlands and or any other impacts within the lot.

Proposed Improvements

The proposed improvements are to remove the existing front porch entrance and replace it with an approximate 32' long by 4' wide open porch. The side stairs will be replaced with 4' wide stairs tied to the porch from a 4' wide landing on the westerly side of existing house. The rear upper deck and stairs will be removed and replaced with a 27.8' long x 9' wide deck with 4' wide stairs on the westerly side. Soil will be removed under the deck and replaced with crushed stone measuring approximately 35.7'x 10.5'. A concrete slab (28.7' x 9') will be placed over the crushed stone. A screened in porch accessed from the daylight basement will be constructed under the deck on the concrete slab.
