After discussion between Mr. Peterlein and Jim Seymour of Sebago Technics it was agreed that it would be better to be 12' wide with 2' grass shoulders. The Applicant will need to get a road name application. The Applicant is planning on calling it Swett Drive.

In order to be able to transfer the nonconforming use to another nonconforming use Mr. Emmons will need a letter from the current owner stating that the business has been going on/being used for the last year in the nonconforming use. Also, Mr. Emmons will need to explain how he meets the requirements of §504.4 of the CLUC.
