- The library employs 2 full time and 4 part time staff
- 840 people accessed the computers and internet
- 90 participants met to discuss books and ideas
- Almost 15,000 visited the stacks
- **360** Community **meetings** are held at the library yearly
- 5 Arts and Crafts groups meet monthly at the library
- 5 Child and teen programs serve over 187 participants

- The Community Room is available to rent for private functions
- 1,939 patrons hold library cards, 35% of town residents
- 16,085 books circulated last year, including 1,863
   eBooks accessed through the Cloud Library, and about
   70 items are added to the collection each month
