Total estimated debt service of this bond issue or contract is 1,754,546 of which principal is 1,400,000 and estimated interest rates ranging from 4.27 - 4.77%, depending on the year of maturity, over 10 years is 354,546.

The amount of interest to be paid will vary depending upon the rate of interest and the years to maturity at the time of issue. The validity of the bonds and of the voters' ratification of the bonds may not be affected by any errors in the estimates made of the costs involved, including varying interest rates, the estimated cost of interest on the bond amount to be issued and the total cost of principal and interest to be paid at maturity.
